Standards

The Worship Leader is called to have an active and vibrant relationship with Jesus and to love God with their whole hearts and their neighbors as themselves.

Definition of Employment Status

This shall be deemed to be a part-time position.

Duties and Responsibilities

As a general summary, the Worship Leader will oversee the “Worship Arts” portion of our church. From leading the congregation in worship to developing eye catching media, they will be actively adding to the overall experience of the church service.

Technology is an important part of the job. You need to have a working knowledge of computers and should be aware of how to use social media, basic video editing and EZ Worship.

Recruiting and training skills will be expected. We are not looking for a lone ranger or a superstar, but want a team player who isn't just on the field, but it willing to call the plays on the field as they direct the team.

Knowledge, skills, and abilities

2. Be a self- starter and be able to recruit and train volunteers.
